The Central Lancashire Section of the VMCC Ltd will hold on Saturday 16th May 2026, a social run of approximately 60 miles. A shorter run consisting of two loops of approximately 20-25 miles each is an option for older machines (and / or riders!). The routes will be over metalled roads. Riding numbers and suggested route sheets will be issued at the start. A limited breakdown assistance service will be available.

This is a non-competitive event.
